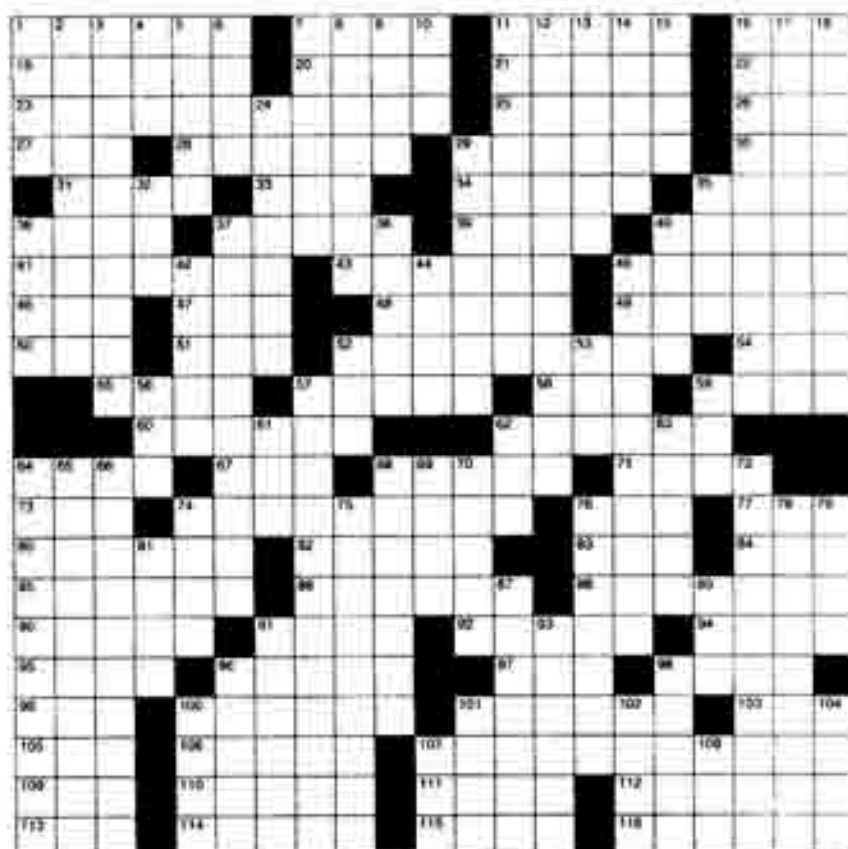

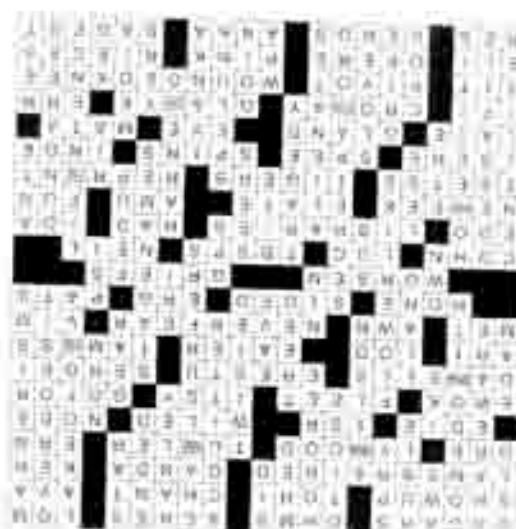

### Zero Tolerance Policy

To maintain an atmosphere which promotes the enjoyment of bridge as both a competitive and social game, the ACBL adopted the ACBL's policy of courteous behavior. For tournaments to be fun, cooperation from all (players, organizers, staff, and volunteers) is necessary.

Also, please report especially outstanding or refreshing conduct on a player memo form (available from any director or on the information table).

#### Commendable

- Being a good "host" or "guest" at the table
- Greeting others in a friendly manner
- Praising the bidding and/or play of the opponents

#### Unacceptable

- Badgering, rudeness, insinuations, intimidation, profanity, threats, or violence
- Negative comments concerning opponent's or partner's play or bidding
- Gloating over good results
- Constant and gratuitous lessons and analyses at the table
- Loud and disruptive arguing with a tournament director
- Ringing cell phones or pagers
- Continuing slow play
